On November 7, 2019 the Faculty Association at University of Northern BC went out on strike and UNITE HERE Local 40 cafeteria workers, along with the CUPE facilities staff, began honouring the professors' picket line. For more than 20 days Local 40 members have stayed out of work to support the Faculty Association which means that their Employer is not contributing for their health care benefits. The loss of health care hours in November will effect benefit eligibility for these members for the full spring & summer 2020 benefits. To avoid loss of eligibility we want to make contributions in November to protect benefits & average hours calculation for future eligibility.
